2. Do you favor or oppose providing a way for illegal immigrants currently in the country to gain legal citizenship if they pass background checks, pay fines, and have jobs?

Favor	46%

3. Do you support or oppose President Obama's decision to use an executive order to delay deportation proceedings against illegal immigrants who are parents of US citizens?

4. Do you think President Obama should or should not have waited for Congress to pass an immigration reform law?
