The Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn was recently shown sitting on the floor of a Virgin Train service from London to Newcastle. He was reported to have been forced to sit on the floor because the train was overcrowded and there were no unreserved seats available. Later Mr Corbyn was able to sit down after a family were upgraded to first class. Virgin Trains has responded, releasing CCTV footage and saying there were seats available and that Mr Corbyn walked past them on his way through the train.

Jeremy Corbyn has now admitted there were empty seats on the train and claimed Virgin Trains just released the footage because of his opinions on nationalising the railways
