Unfair	45%
Not sure	25%

3. Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of the Islamic religion?

Very favorable	5%
Somewhat favorable	15%
Somewhat unfavorable	26%
Very unfavorable	29%
Not sure	26%

4. Do you agree or disagree with the following statement: "I would not advocate that we put a Muslim in charge of this nation."

Strongly agree	37%
Somewhat agree	20%
Somewhat disagree	11%
Strongly disagree	16%
Not sure	17%

5. The statement in the previous question was made by presidential candidate Ben Carson. Do you think he should or should not apologize for making that statement?

Should apologize	30%
Should not apologize	52%
