Notes on Methodology

- These estimates include the 632 constituencies in England, Scotland and Wales, but not the 18 constituencies in Northern Ireland.
- YouGov collected vote intention data from 40119 respondents between 2-7 February 2019. While this does not yield enough observations in individual constituencies to treat the data as separate constituency polls, we can look for patterns in responses across constituencies that have similar characteristics, and then work out the implications of those patterns for each constituency. This strategy of "multilevel regression and post-stratification" or *MRP* is the same approach we used in the 2017 YouGov election model that correctly predicted the hung parliament and 93% of individual constituency winners.
- Doing a constituency-level analysis in the absence of an immediate election raises some challenges that are not present in the period immediately before an election. For the 2017 election model we provided candidate lists to each respondent for their constituency. We do not yet know what candidates would run in a new election, and so we provided the 2017 candidate lists under the prompt: "The following people were the parliamentary candidates standing in the election on June 8th 2017. Imagine there was an election tomorrow and the same or similar candidates ran, who would you vote for?"
- Regardless of whether the parties stood candidates at the last election, we included response options for Con, Lab, LD, UKIP, Green and Other in all English, Scottish and Welsh constituencies, plus SNP in Scotland and PC in Wales. Where there was no candidate last time, we listed only the party; where there was a candidate last time, we listed the party and the candidate. At the last election the Green Party and UKIP did not stand candidates in all constituencies, and much of the estimated increase in the performance of those parties since 2017 is attributable to all respondents having the possibility of voting for these parties.
