YouGov weights GB political surveys by (1) age interlocked with education, (2) political attention (3) social grade (4) 2015 recalled vote interlocked with region and (5) EU referendum voting intention. Weighting targets are YouGov estimates, data sources used in the calculation of targets are cited below. General election voting intention figures are additionally weighted by likelihood to vote. The poll was carried out online.
