Vignette

Split 1:America is changing, becoming increasingly diverse. In 2014, for the first time in the nation's history, more minority babies were born than white babies. Whites are a minority in 22 of the top 100 US metro areas as well as four states, including the two largest, Texas and California. The Census Bureau projects that in 25 years non-Hispanic whites will be a minority in America. We should embrace our diversity, which gives America an advantage in the global economy. Together, we can build a stronger, more inclusive America.

Split 2:Immigration has risen and fallen over time, but, like the English language, America's culture is only superficially affected by foreign influence. According to Professor Richard Alba of the State University of New York at Albany, brisk intermarriage between Hispanics and whites, and the fact their children assimilate into the English-speaking traditions of America, mean the share of Americans with European ancestry is likely to grow, not decline. Like the Irish and Italians a century ago, Hispanic and Asian immigrants are assimilating. Now as in the past, immigrant minorities will be absorbed into the majority and foreign identities will fade, as they have for public figures with Latino ancestors such as Ted Williams or Cameron Diaz. America shapes its immigrants, immigration doesn't shape America.
