What will I be doing day to day?

- Understanding Business Requirements and User Requirements
 Discovering, analysing, defining, and documenting the requirements that are related to a
 specific business objective. And it's the process by which you clearly and precisely define
 the scope of the project, so that you can assess the timescales and resources needed to
 complete it.
 - o Considering the human-computer interaction (HCI) element of a design
 - Considering existing applications and evaluating their UX (user experience)
 effectiveness
 - Facilitate client's product visions by researching, conceiving, wire framing, sketching, prototyping, and mocking up user experiences for digital products
 - Conducting A/B tests to measure user response
- Information Architecture
 - This is the structural design of shared information environments; the art and science of organizing and labelling websites, intranets, online communities and software to support usability and findability.
- User Flows Diagrams
 - Study and define the path a user follows through the interface to complete a task (make a reservation, purchase a product, and subscribe to something), effectively the user's journey.

 Sketch out visual representations of a user interface, stripped of any visual design or branding elements. It is to define the hierarchy of items on a screen and communicate what the items on that page should be based on user needs.

Communication

 Communicating scenarios (hypothetical users), end-to-end experiences, interaction models, and screen designs with clients and key stakeholders
