ISSUE QUESTION

Ms Trad has denied any wrongdoing, and has promised to sell the property.

YouGov Weighting

YouGov weighted this survey by (1) age interlocked with gender and region (2) education (3) previous election voting intention. Weighting targets are YouGov estimates derived for voters from ABS statistics. The survey was carried out online. The theoretical margin of error on a 50% figure at 95% confidence for a sample of this size is $\pm 3.1\%$. All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error some of which may not be represented in the theoretical margin of error.
