- Should have been included 20%
 - Right to exclude him 70%
 - Don't know 10%

Should players be randomly tested for drink and drug abuse?

- Yes frequently 81%
- Yes occasionally 16
 - No **2%**
 - Don't know 2%

Do you agree or disagree with this statement: 'High wages are largely to blame for bad behaviour among professional footballers.'

- Agree strongly 32%
- Tend to agree 42%
- Tend to disagree 17%
- Disagree strongly 4%
 - Don't know 6%

Do you believe there should be a maximum wage for professional footballers?

- Yes, less than £1,000 a week (less than £50,000 a year) 23%
 - Yes, around £1,000 a week (around £50,000 a year) 19%
- Yes, between £1,500 and £5,000 a week (between £80,000 and £250,000 a year) **21%**
