YouGov questioned a representative sample of 1,532 electors online on 15 March 2004

Do you think the United States and Britain were right or wrong to take military action against Iraq?

Right	48%
Wrong	41%

Do you think Britain's role in the Iraq war has made the country more vulnerable or less vulnerable to attack by Islamic terrorists?

More vulnerable	75%
Less vulnerable	1%
Made no difference	22%

(To those who voted Labour in 2001) **Has Britain's participation in the war in Iraq made you more likely or less likely to vote Labour at the next general election?**

More likely	8%
Less likely	27%

Would a terrorist attack in Britain, like the one in Madrid last Thursday, make you more likely or less likely to support Labour in the next general election?

(To those who voted Conservative in 2001) **Has the Conservatives' support for the Iraq war made you more likely or less likely to support them next time?**

More likely	9%
Less likely	5%
Made no difference – I would have voted Conservative anyway	77%
Made no difference – I would NOT have voted Conservative anyway	4%
Don't know	5%

(To those less likely to vote Conservative.... VERY SMALL BASE of only 32 respondents) **If you did switch from the Conservatives, which party would you vote for?**

Labour	1%
Liberal Democrat	36%
Scottish Nationalist / Plaid Cymru	23%

Would not vote	14%
Don't know	12%

(To all those less likely to vote Labour or Conservative) **The Liberal Democrats opposed the war in Iraq. Would this make you more likely to support them next time?**

More likely	60%
Less likely	6%
Make no difference – I would have voted Lib Dem anyway	4%
Make no difference – I would NOT have voted Lib Dem anyway	21%
Don't know	9%
